cost\_tuition\_in [numeric] In-state tuition and fees. (TUITIONFEE\_IN)

cost\_tuition\_out [numeric] Out-of-state tuition and fees. (TUITIONFEE\_OUT)

cost\_books [numeric] Cost of attendance: estimated books and supplies. (BOOKSUPPLY)

cost\_room\_board\_on [numeric] Cost of attendance: on-campus room and board. (ROOMBOARD\_ON)

- cost\_room\_board\_off [numeric] Cost of attendance: off-campus room and board. (ROOMBOARD\_OFF)
- cost\_avg [numeric] Average net price for Title IV institutions (private for-profit and nonprofit
  institutions). (NPT4\_PRIV)
- cost\_avg\_income\_0\_30k [numeric] Average net price for \$0-\$30,000 family income (private for-profit and nonprofit institutions). (NPT41\_PRIV)

- score\_sat\_math\_p25 [numeric] 25th percentile of SAT scores at the institution (math). (SATMT25)
- score\_sat\_math\_p75 [numeric] 75th percentile of SAT scores at the institution (math). (SATMT75)
